

Call for Submission of Proposals for R&D Projects under BIS R&D Scheme - Phase 4

In continuation of its strategy for research-based standardization, Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) has launched Phase 4 of R&D Projects, in line with the BIS R&D Guidelines. Under this phase, a total of 32 projects (15 new and 17 carried forward from earlier phases) have been hosted on the BIS Portal. These projects are aimed at generating empirical data, insights, and technical evidence to support the formulation of new Indian Standards and the revision of existing ones.

Academic institutions & universities having MoU with BIS and faculties and research scholars thereof, members of Technical Committees of BIS and government research laboratories of repute like CSIR, DRDO, ICAR etc. are encouraged to participate in these projects by submitting their proposals. The projects are designed to strengthen the standardization ecosystem through research-driven inputs and enrich the research environment in academic and professional institutions.

The last date for submission of proposals is 25 September 2025.
